Microsoft Copilot Chat is included in the M365 licences most trusts already hold. Within a properly governed framework, these tools and others freely available meet most of what staff need day to day.

What governance actually means for Ofsted.

Ofsted does not inspect AI tools in isolation. Inspectors look at governance: whether AI use is safe, consistent and properly overseen. A trust with a documented framework is in a fundamentally different inspection position from one without.

Safeguarding is now a binary judgement under the new Ofsted framework: met or not met. An AI-related safeguarding incident in a school with no policy and no documented approach is a safeguarding not met risk.

The framework is what protects your trust. Not the tools.

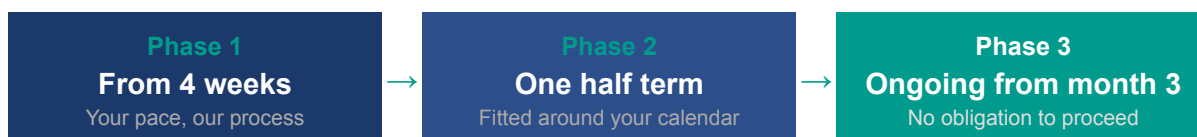
